SWIMMING POOL BOARD

24.01 Purpose
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24.04 Powers and Duties
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24.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of this chapter is to provide for the creation and appointment of a Swimming Pool Board and to specify the Board's powers and duties.

24.02 BOARD ESTABLISHED. A Swimming Pool Board is established to manage and oversee the Wapello Community Swimming Pool.

24.03 ORGANIZATION. The Board shall consist of five members, all citizens of the City, appointed by the Mayor with the majority approval of the Council for three-year terms. Members shall serve without compensation. Any vacancies shall be filled by appointment of the Mayor with the approval of the Council.

24.04 POWERS AND DUTIES. The Board shall have and exercise the following powers and duties:

1. Meet and elect from its members a President, Secretary, and such other officers, as it deems necessary.
2. Meet at least once each quarter of each year and at such other times as are deemed by the Board to be necessary and appropriate. All meetings are subject to the Iowa Open Meetings Law, and open to the public with proper notice. Furthermore, minutes are to be kept and the original permanently kept on file in the office of the Clerk.
3. Manage and oversee the Wapello Community Swimming Pool and its facilities. Such management shall include the power to make rules and regulations for the use of the swimming pool or other recreational facilities connected with it.
4. Authorize the use of the swimming pool by residents and nonresidents of the City and to fix charges therefor.

24.05 REPORTS. The Board shall make reports to the Council of its activities and expenditures of funds from time to time as it deems advisable or upon Council request, but at least once each year. Its revenues and expenditures shall be reported monthly to the Clerk, and a copy shall be provided to each member of the Board and in the Clerk's report to the Council.

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
